5. DISCUSSION RELATED TO THE WATER RESOUCES DEVELOPMENT ACT (WRDA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000,000 (\$4 MILLION)

The Subcommittee will discuss the WRDA grant, which was adopted for pursuit by the Board of Directors on September 11, 2024. The grant requests design and planning assistance from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under Section 219 of the Water Resources Development Act, WRDA, of 1992, for design and planning of a municipal sewer project to serve the Los Olivos Community Services District for up to \$4 Million (\$4,000,000). All work would be carried out by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

President Kennedy opens the floor to public comment.

GM Savage provides an introduction to the item. Importantly, he notes that he has asked Directory Fayram to find someone who can speak to working with the Corps at a future full Board of Director's meeting. The group discusses potential approaches matching, working with the grant. President Kennedy suggests we reach out to Congressman Carabajal's office to better understand potential – focused on match and timeline.
